Subject: Price increase effective from 2nd May 2022

Please be advised effective 2nd May 2022 we will be having a price increase.

External factors continued to put significant upward pressure on product costs. We've seen significant increases in logistic input costs mainly driven by the Covid impact globally and more recently the Russia/Ukraine crisis with fuel costs rising significantly.

Rising inflation is also impacting on input costs such as product manufacturing material costs and import base costs. Certain material shortages are also adding to the rising input costs.
